Page Size and limit:

Each paper is limited to 8 pages on standard size Letter (11x 8.5) paper.

Font:

The recommended font size is 10 in Arial narrow. Template is available in the website of BUET (www.buet.ac.bd)

Titles and author:

Give the paper it's Title and then enter authors Name. Title and Institute/company, country, Fax and e-mail in Arial narrow (12 point font size).

Headings and Sub-headings:

Headings and sub-headings are in bold Arial Narrow font (14 Points font size for headings and 10 point font size for sub-headings) with initials in capital letter without any underline. It should start at the left margin on a separate line and should not be indented.

References:

Referencing should preferably follow the Harvard system (Author's surname, followed by publication year in the main text; Bibliography in alphabetic order compiled at the end of the paper). Footnotes can be given if desired by putting reference number in the text in 9 pt. (ARIAL Narrow) superscript.¹

Headers and footers:

On top and bottom of each page of the template some standardized information is given.

Paragraphs:

Paragraphs should start immediately from next line after the heading or subheading. There will be one line gap between paragraphs. No indentation will be allowed.

Illustration:

Use number consecutively: Fig.1, Fig.2 etc. in bold (font 9). Compose the page with illustrations as that of the main text, keeping similar margins. Width of the illustrations should not exceed 6 inches (width of column).Prefered width will be either 3 or 6 inches.

Originals must be provided separately in soft copy.

Standard Template:

Follow the given Protibesh standard template. Page size – Letter, Left margin 1", right margin 1.5", single column (6" wide).
